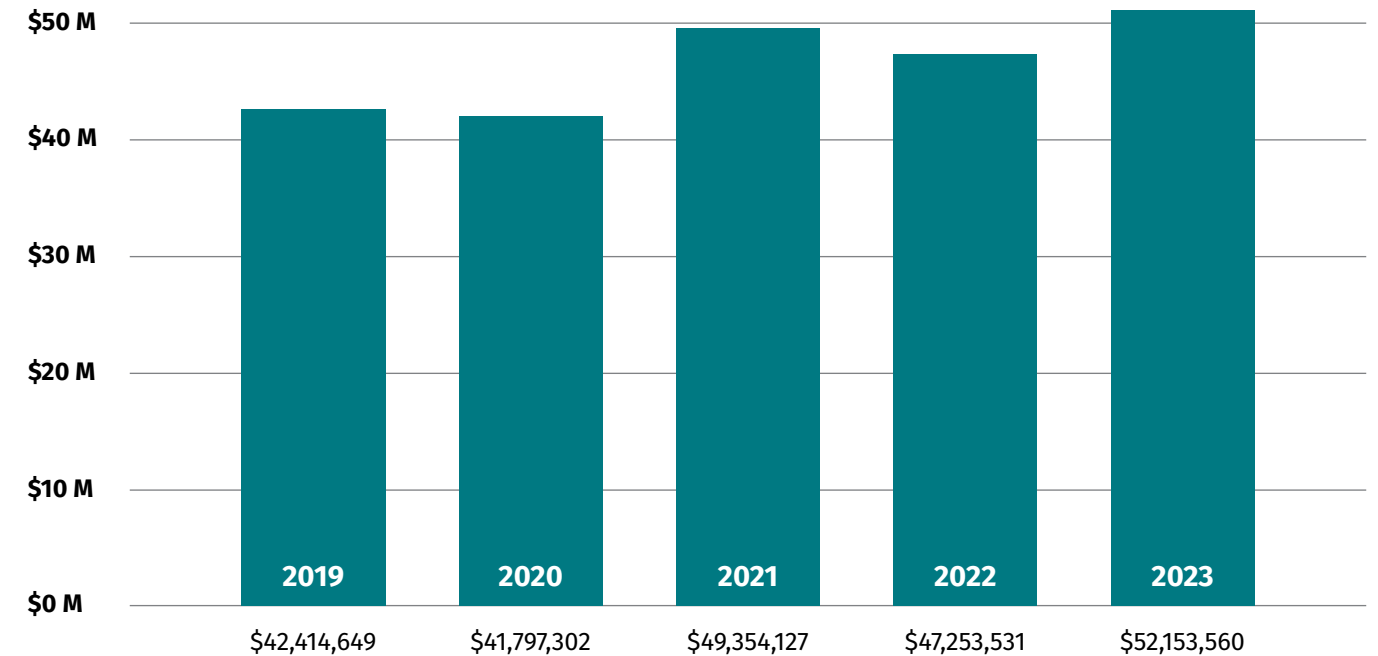

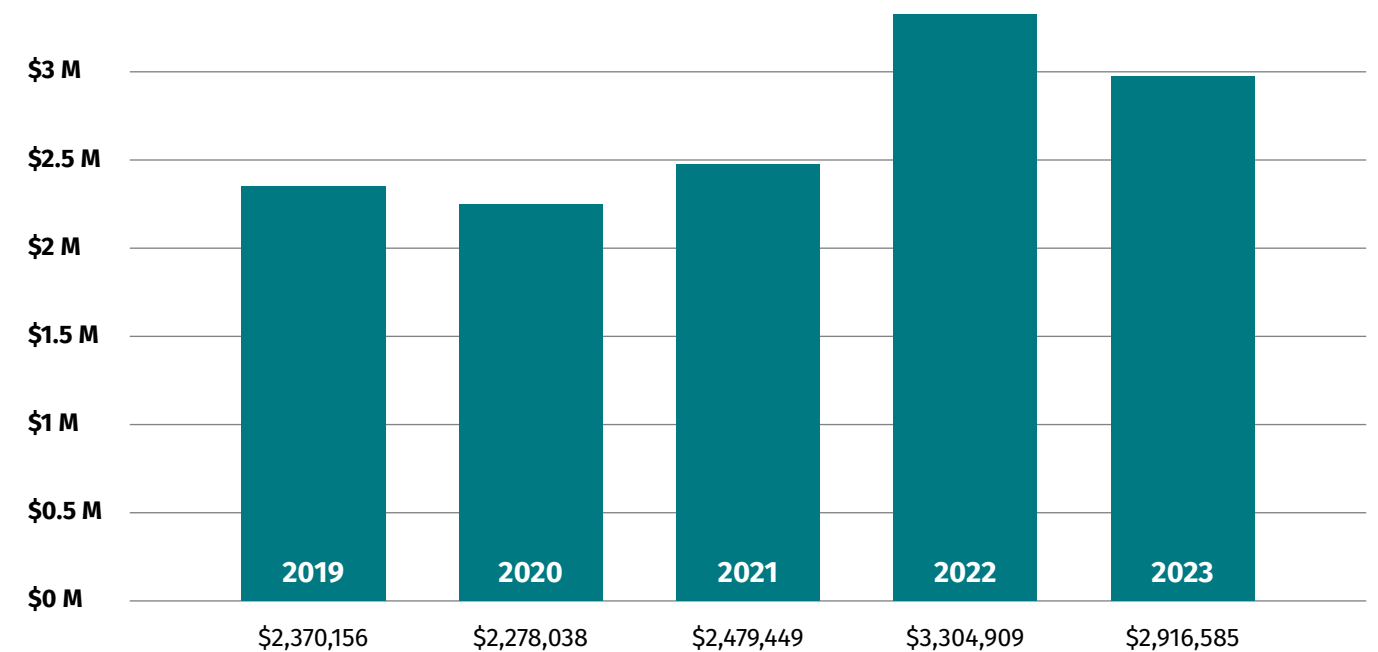
CSI Foundation Assets

Janice Seagraves Family Foundation Establishes Fire Science Scholarship

The Fire Science program meets the educational needs of both those who desire to become firefighters and those currently employed in the field who are looking to advance their knowledge base. The program provides opportunities for students to earn multiple fire service credentials. CSI offers an

associate of applied science and an intermediate technical certificate in Fire Science.

Miriam's dedication to the students at the College of Southern Idaho did not end with her service on the Foundation Board. She and her husband, John, created the John and Miriam Breckenridge Endowment together. This established the Breckenridge Ag Endowment farm to be used for the benefit of the students at the College of Southern Idaho. The College of Southern Idaho Foundation, Inc. is deeply grateful to the Breckenridge family. The Foundation further supports the efforts of the CSI Ag Department in carrying out the visions of Miriam and John.

About the Farm

The Breckenridge Endowment Farm is owned by the CSI Foundation and maintained by CSI and the Agriculture Department. The Breckenridge Endowment Farm provides hands-on learning opportunities for CSI Ag students.

Current courses that utilize the Breckenridge Farm for instruction include: Plant Science, Crop Production, Pest Management, Geospatial Information Systems (GIS), GPS, Precision Agriculture, Soils, Spatial Analysis with GIS, Plant Nutrition, Irrigation Systems, Water Measurement, Water Quality, Wildland Plant ID, Principles of Range Management, Forage Crops, and Science of Animal Husbandry.

The CSI Ag department also provides hosted educational experiences for the community and K-12 partners. Community partnerships include garden plots and an MOU with Mid-Snake Resource Conservation and Development to maintain an educational firewise garden.

Top Finishers, 2022-2023 Athletics

CSI Eagles soar to new heights.

Cross Country/Distance Track

The Golden Eagle Women's Cross-Country Team won the NJCAA Division I National Championship in the fall. It was their second straight title. The CSI Men's Team placed ninth at nationals. Both teams also excelled in the classroom. The women posted a 3.68 GPA and the men finished with a 3.34 GPA. Individually, the men's and women's teams had 12 All-Americans throughout the three seasons. Eight runners from both teams will be competing at the next level this fall.



CSI Rodeo

The College of Southern Idaho Rodeo Men's Team won the Rocky Mountain Region Championship, qualifying for the College National Finals Rodeo. Individually, Raegan Steed placed fourth in the country in Breakaway Roping and Sage Allen took seventh overall in Bareback Riding. In addition, the team had a 3.30 GPA in the classroom.

CSI Women's Basketball

The Golden Eagles won the Scenic West Athletic Conference Title, the Region 18 Title and tied for third in the country at the NJCAA National Tournament in Lubbock, Texas. That was the second-highest finish in CSI Women's Basketball history. They also stood out in the classroom with a 3.23 GPA. Nine players from this past year's team will be moving on to be student-athletes at four-year universities. They also had one All American, Kaylee Headrick, who will be returning this fall.

CSI Softball

The College of Southern Idaho Softball Team won the Region 18 Title and competed in the NJCAA College World Series in Oxford, Alabama. The Golden Eagles also posted a 3.52 GPA in the classroom. The Golden Eagles had two NFCA All Americans and two NJCAA All Americans. Six players from the 2022 team will be playing softball this coming year at the next level.

CSI Men's Basketball

The Golden Eagle Men's Basketball became just the second CSI Men's Basketball Team to finish the regular season undefeated. CSI won the Scenic West Athletic Conference Title and tied for ninth at the NJCAA National Tournament. Seven players signed to play basketball at four-year colleges and universities. In the classroom, the men posted a 3.32 GPA.

CSI Baseball

The Golden Eagles had two players drafted in the Major League Baseball Draft. They had one NJCAA All American. They also finished with a team GPA of 3.60 and had a department high 23 players earn Academic All-American honors in the classroom.

CSI Cheer Team

In 2023 the team won its first ever national championship at the USA Collegiate Championships in Anaheim, Calif. The Golden Eagles won the Two-Year Show Division.

CSI Volleyball

The Golden Eagles finished the season as a NJCAA Academic Team, posting a 3.13 GPA. The Golden Eagles had seven sophomores move on to the next level. 🏆

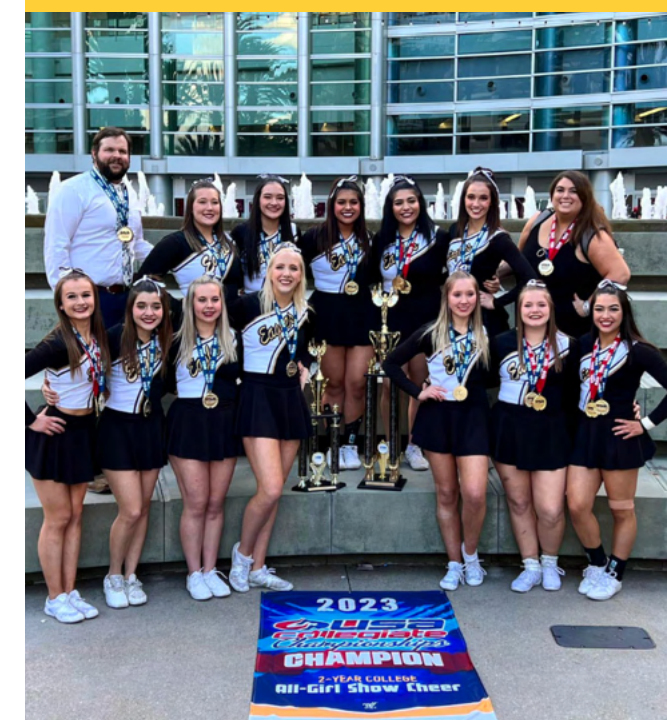

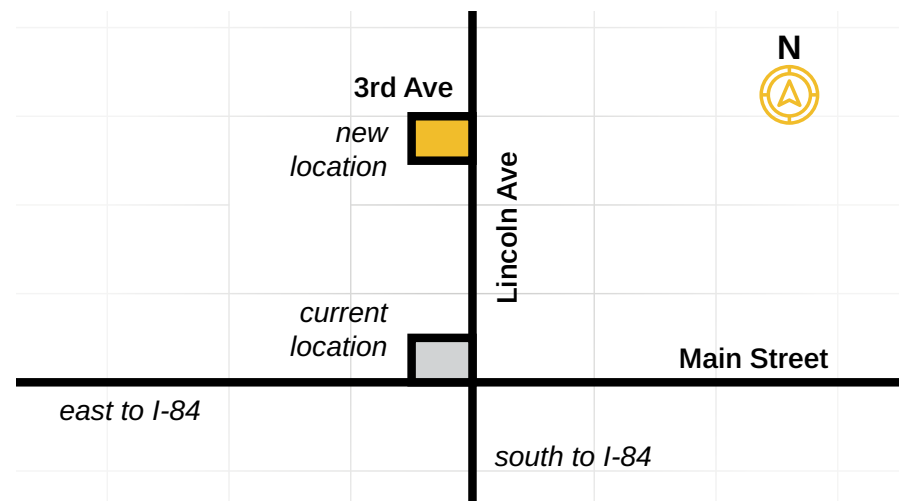

The Ag & Diesel Technology Center is estimated to be a 28,000 square foot facility dedicated to career technical education (CTE) programs providing training in diesel truck, heavy equipment, and agricultural equipment. In 2022, the Idaho Legislature appropriated \$10 million towards the facility as recommended by Governor Brad Little. The Center will be shared with the Twin Falls School District (and possibly others) which will provide access to CSI programs to high school students prior to and after high school graduation. The Center will also provide availability of transportation sector training space in support of the Daimler Truck/Freightliner program and provide the opportunity for significant expansion of the sector workforce pipeline.

Heavy Equipment & Ag Technology

The program provides preparation for technicians to repair and care for heavy construction equipment, tractors, and other diesel-powered implements. Students are certified and proficient in shop safety, engine, electrical, HVAC, hydraulics and powertrain as well as basic welding and fabrication. Many students find work prior to graduation and complete the program in a work-based learning environment.

Industry & Workforce Training

Providing short term and custom training on special topics in support of the transportation sector.

Diesel Technology

The program provides instruction on service technology for medium duty to Class 8 diesel powered trucks. This program works closely with Daimler Trucks/Freightliner service training and provides access to current training aids including actual Freightliner and Sterling trucks. Students learn preventative maintenance, service, and repair of diesel trucks including electrical systems, fuel systems, engines, and drivetrain. Graduates are workplace-ready and employable, ready to perform all aspects of truck and diesel engine repair.

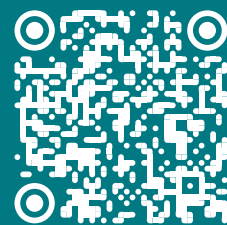

One of those passions was video gaming and Esports and Wacey was able to join the Boise State Esports team and devote time to becoming their first national title holder in 2021. He went on to be a two-time Madden NFL champion, earning college scholarships and winning events at the National Association of College Esports. Wacey graduated from Boise State with his Bachelor's in Psychology and has interests in organizational psychology and sports performance.

What made you choose CSI?

Travis and Heather initially chose CSI for three specific reasons:

1. The chance to participate in rodeo under the guidance of Shawn Davis.
2. The educational opportunities provided by the community college environment.
3. The proximity to their families.

Heather and Travis were very invested in their rodeo careers and the rodeo industry. Travis was riding bulls professionally and Heather was competing in women's events and worked as a rodeo secretary at events. Heather shared, "We were competitive in the arena, but we both thought we could learn more about the other aspects of rodeo. We saw CSI as an ideal place to gain knowledge about rodeo production from some of the industry's finest experts."

Heather and Travis gained valuable insights during their time at CSI, not only from the rodeo experiences with Shawn Davis but also from interactions with students and the community. The leadership positions they held on the rodeo team provided valuable lessons in managing complex organizations and interacting with people. Shawn's coaching style emphasized learning through hands-on experience, teaching fundraising, networking, and event management. The rodeo program was deeply integrated into the community and allowed the athletes to engage with student affairs, campus leadership, other athletes, and local businesses.

Heather and Travis spent a year at Utah State. Where Travis excelled in his animal science/

agribusiness programs, Heather faced challenges in her engineering major due to large class sizes and daunting math courses. Both came from small rural towns and the transition to large classes, potentially taught by teaching assistants, was unappealing. Heather explained.

Like many first-generation and rural students at CSI, Heather's confidence was greatly boosted by Bob "Mac" McElfresh, which had a lasting impact on her academic journey, especially as she pursued her doctoral degree.

For Wyatt and Wacey, the decision to enroll at CSI was about access, opportunity, and the quality of their education. CSI gave them access to courses that aligned with their future goals, while accommodating their high school schedules. The CSI community warmly embraced them, allowing them to attend both online and in-person classes and access resources that simplified their experience. They had instructors who nurtured their self-assurance as learners and pushed them to next level.

Did you continue your education after CSI, and if so, how?

Heather went on to finish her Bachelor's in Biological Sciences and Secondary Education at Idaho State University. She later earned both a Master's of Educational Leadership and a Doctorate of Education from the University of Idaho.

Wyatt went to Boise State University for a year and transferred to Tarleton State University in Texas, where he pursued a Bachelor's in Communications while participating on their rodeo team. Wyatt's rodeo achievements include winning Tie Down Roping for the Northwest Region NIRA in 2017 and Reserve Champion for the Southwest Region in Tie Down Roping for Tarleton. He also competed twice at the College National Finals Rodeo (CNFR). Wyatt acquired his real estate license and launched his real estate career. Currently he is obtaining his health and nutrition education coaching credentials with the National Academy of Sports Medicine.

What have you been up to since CSI?

For 25 years, the family's residence was in Gooding where Travis' education helped to establish Teacup Ranch, a farm and ranch. Summers were dedicated to rodeoing and tending to cattle. Heather was employed by the Gooding Schools, as a high school biology and psychology teacher and later as an administrator and superintendent. Both Travis and Heather actively coached youth sports as well as helped with 4-H, youth rodeos, and community events.

In 2014, Heather transitioned to Boise State University and currently serves as a Department Chair and Program Coordinator for the Executive Educational Leadership

Program. Her research primarily focuses on leadership and enhancing rural communities. She assists with national superintendent searches and offers school improvement consultancy services, by providing training and technical support to school leaders, teachers, governing boards and the communities they serve. Travis manages the family cattle in both Glens Ferry and Arbon Valley.

Following college, Wyatt and Wacey both explored various jobs within their degree fields and have coached while following their career paths. Wacey plays a pivotal role on the Teacup Ranch as a jack of all trades. Wyatt returned to Idaho and took a coaching role for the Glens Ferry football team. He works in real estate for Rockin K Real Estate in Gooding and also contributes to the family's ranch operations.

How do you like to spend your time now?

The family enjoys spending time outdoors and on their ranch. They like riding in the mountains and roping in their arena. They cherish friendly and competitive games, particularly pinochle and ping pong, playing with neighbors and family members when they have the chance. Wyatt and Wacey, developed a passion for golf, and you'll often find them on a golf course during their free moments.

Occasionally, they indulge in leisurely travel and relish the opportunity to savor delicious food, a special perk of living in Idaho with access to an abundance of quality local produce. Exploring local producers and hidden gems for dining in our region is something they take pleasure in. 🏡
